WHMIS AND HAZARD COMMUNICATION



All chemicals must be kept in approved and clearly marked containers. If decanting into a smaller jug or pail, employers must provide adequate labels to adhere to the secondary containers.



WHMIS training is mandatory. Employees working with or near hazardous chemicals should review their WHMIS program every twelve months. Workplace labels should be chosen and standardized whenever possible. Training on how to properly mark WHMIS labels is critical to ensure your program runs smoothly.



Material Safety Data Sheets must be available for employees to review when required. They must also be kept current (no older than three years). Your MSDS station should be kept near chemical inventories and where chemicals are decanted and handled regularly.
